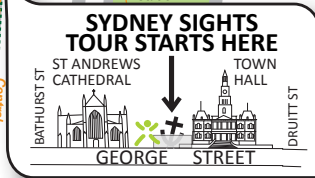

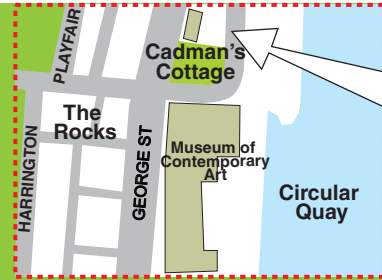


Note: The Sydney Sights tour finishes near Circular Quay.
